- Acting responsibly towards the environment and the community.
- Accurately represent your own competence when seeking and accepting assignments.
- Complying with relevant laws, regulations, and professional standards.

Members of AITD demonstrate Connecting by

- Valuing and leveraging diverse skills and perspectives.
- Promoting a culture of inclusivity and diversity.
- Respecting privacy, protecting confidential and sensitive information.
- Recognising and acting on actual, perceived, or potential conflicts of interest.

Members of AITD demonstrate Sharing by

- Contributing to the learning and development profession.
- Encouraging collaboration and open communication.
- Fostering a nurturing environment for development and growth.
- Advocating for the learning and development industry responsibly and professionally.
- Treating all individuals with dignity and respect, regardless of background or perspective.
